Abstract Categories

- Diabetes Mellitus/ Prediabetes
- Endocrinology
- Nutrition

General Instructions for submission

- All abstracts should be submitted online through the abstract submission web portal. (<http://abstract.slendo.lk>)
 - Please note that there is no facility to submit hard copies directly to the SLENDO office, *please do not send abstracts via email.*
- The language of the entries should be set to English (UK).
- All abstracts should be uploaded at SLENDO online portal **on or before 31st August 2022**. Late entries will not be accepted.
- The author/s should take full public responsibility for the research work/case reports and the contents reported in the abstract.
- The names of all authors and the affiliations should be entered in the cage provided in the web portal.
- Author's name should be given only as Last name followed by initial(s). Prefixes such as Mr., Dr. or Professor should not be mentioned (Eg: Perera AB).
- Affiliations: mention the affiliations in the appropriate cage in the web portal.
- By submitting the abstract, you agree to present the abstract if selected for presentations (poster/oral) at the SLENDO 2022 – Colombo, Sri Lanka.

SLENDO 2022 reserves the right to make alterations and to edit the contents of the abstract to improve the quality of the presentation.

Format of an abstract

Research Category

The title of the abstract: Should be brief but adequately descriptive.

Background / Introduction: One or two sentences to indicate the gravity of the problem.

Objectives: The main objective/s of the study.

Methods: Give sufficient details of study setting, subjects, selection process, measurements and analyses. Indicate the statistics used to analyze data. (Need not indicate the software used for statistical analyses.)

Results: Sufficient data to address objectives and support conclusions.

Conclusions: Should be based on results and observations of the study. References and acknowledgements are not required. However, these can be included in the presentation.

Word Limit: 300 words only

Case Report Category

The title of the abstract: Should be brief but adequately descriptive.

Background/ Introduction: Briefly describe the background for the case, explain why this case is noteworthy and what it adds to current knowledge.

Case Description: Relevant information may include basic demographics, patient's main symptoms or other reasons for seeking care, clinical assessment, treatment plan, and health outcomes. Given the space limitations, include only the information relevant.

Conclusion: This section should emphasize the learning point(s) and implications for clinical practice highlighted in the case.

Word Limit: 300 words

Informing the authors

- Abstracts not conforming to the above instructions will be rejected
- The SLCE reserves the right to decide the mode of the presentation at SLENDO 2022 (Oral/Poster).
- The corresponding author of each successful paper selected will be informed by email on or before end of the September.
- Please note that NO amendments to the submitted abstracts (including the number of authors) would be entertained thereafter.
